

SUPPORTERS OF THE SAVINGS FOR WORKING FAMILIES ACT

The Savings for Working Families Act (S. 985/H.R. 2277) ensures that our nation's savings and ownership policies assist working-poor families by enabling them to save, build wealth, and enter the financial mainstream through the use of a financial product tailored to their needs: Individual Development Accounts (IDAs).

Under the bill, IDAs would be available to 2.7 million citizens or legal residents of the U.S. between the ages of 18 and 60 (except students), and whose federal adjusted gross income does not exceed \$20,000 (single), \$30,000 (head of household), or \$40,000 (married).
